## NON - CONFIDENTIAL FACTS AND ADVICE TO THE POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER

### INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 (the Act) provides that, under schedule 1, paragraph 14, a police and crime commissioner (PCC) may do anything which is calculated to facilitate, or is conducive or incidental to, the exercise of the functions of commissioner.
2. To facilitate the functions of the police and crime commissioner it is necessary to have in place a range of policies which ensure compliance with the statutory provisions which apply to police and crime commissioners, including those which relate to the PCC's role as an employer, together with policies that ensure the effective operation of their functions.
3. In recognition of the need to have such policies in place, the following policies for approval are attached as **Annexes** to this paper.
  - Anti-Bribery, corruption and fraud – July 2018
  - Visits to Victims – July 2018
  - Redaction – July 2018
  - FOI – July 2018
  - Equality – July 2018
  - Work Experience – July 2018
  - Legal Assistance for Police Officers – July 2018

These policies are based on the policies already in existence for the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner West Midlands. They have been revised in order to reflect current practice and the structures in place in the OPCC.

The policies will be kept under review and amended as necessary, in the light of the development of the structures, processes and procedures required to support the PCC in the exercise of his functions.
