As you no doubt know, I have been campaigning to stop your police station closure programme which I believe is severely detrimental to our communities that have been affected by rising crime during your tenure as PCC.

On this hot topic, I urge you once more to stop your closure programme and reconsider the approach you have taken while in office to police stations.
