Matches description given by caller. Caller said the person was stabbing the bus stop with a knife. Another officer recorded footage. Panel felt that the officer was calm and polite. Always gained consent from male. General conversation with male put him at ease. Action: SG to pass on positive comments to supervisor. 1.) Males acting suspiciously. Tried to avoid police. Males evaded officers. No property found. Officers looking for weapons due to previous intelligence. Panel felt the officer was polite and persevered to catch male in difficult circumstances. Action: SG to pass on positive comments to supervisor.
4.	Dip sample of Use of Force (UoF) records 2. PC W on subject T. Log 3511/31/1/22.	Officers called to a robbery of a teenagers phone and bank card. 2 males made off and one was detained by a member of the public. Male was Non-compliant with handcuffs. Panel felt officer was calm, officer made the male feel calmer by removing him from the high tension situation. Action: SG to pass on positive comments to supervisor.



	3. PC K on subject K. Log 3450/25/1/22	Firearms officers were called to reports of a male with a knife/sword at the local shop. Shop keeper had removed weapon from male himself.
		Panel felt the armed officer was calm. His tone and demeaner towards the male was good. The officer dealt with the situation quickly and effectively.
