They did very well considering amount of racial abuse being given to them by the suspect. Action: Positive feedback to officer. 1 – call to suggest there was a drunk male in the road which was stopping traffic. Panel Views: Situation was extremely chaotic. Officers first thought was to protect the male from harming himself. Officers did they best they could given the circumstances. Panel felt that UoF was warranted and needed to protect the male.
