Driver/passenger compliant. Panel Views: Text book UoF. Fair and effective UoF. Clear communication throughout. Robbery suspect detained and resisted arrest. Spit hood used prior to and during transportation to custody. Panel Views: Panel felt that the officer was extremely aggressive towards the suspect.
