Hi all,

Further to yesterday's meeting, here is the breakdown of how many bleed kits each area should be getting:

Local Authority	No. bleed kits
Birmingham CC	185

Wolverhampton CC	42

As discussed yesterday please let me know the following:

1. Are you happy with your allocation or do you want more/less (how many if so and then, if possible, we'll allocate them where they're wanted).
2. What name and address to send them to.

Once you have the kits you will need to work out where to distribute them to (though you do not need to distribute them all at once do note the kits have only a limited lifespan so don't leave them lying around for months). As the kits go out you will need to keep a local spreadsheet detailing where they are located (address and location within premises) and email for the main contact at location for the kit. If you can then ensure that:

- A. [REDACTED] is notified so that WMAS know where the kits are located so as to direct a 999 caller to them for emergency first aid
- B. [REDACTED] is provided with your spreadsheet on a monthly basis so that our own website can be updated
- C. Contact [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] regarding training (free) for those who may wish to be trained in use at the locations that the kits are being placed
