	SS6H 8U 330493795	Tracking of a stolen Camper Van: Officers clear on reason for search and rights for record of search. Would have benefitted by trying to build more rapport. Long silences built unnecessary tension.
	SSSH RZ 331456511	Car stopped and search for drugs: Too many reasons given for search were given and some questionable. Based on intelligence? High crime area? Tasking area? Grounds for Stop and Search not clear and not strong enough. Smell of cannabis on a windy day in aa car? Officers polite and respectful but a long delay without any conversation or interaction. No questions about the significant amount of cash found.
5.	Dip sample of Use of Force records	
	MF/03	Mental Health Crisis, officers called to young man's home: Panel acknowledged that this was a very difficult incident to deal with. Although spat at, racially abused and significant resistance shown, the officers remained calm, patient and controlled using the minimum of force. Female officer tried hard to calm the young man. Very professionally handled by all officers.
	JG/01	Domestic at address where partner had phoned police re domestic violence: Person who was arrested resisted and was very uncooperative. Officers remained calm and tried patiently



		to build rapport with little success. Minimum force used and good after care given. Officer in background successful and tactfully kept the complainant for joining the fray.
