	Item Discussed	Actions
1.	Welcome and introduction done by Chair CM	CM asked panel if there were any matters they would like to raise in regards to the previous meeting/ minutes or anything else. No matters raised. CM appointed LD as minute taker for all upcoming meetings.
2.	Feedback from last panel from JG	NC gave a clearer insight into analysing the statistics on the 1 <sup>st</sup> slide. The presented statistics are only a cause for concern if there are significant changes in the data; therefore, they will not be moving forward with detailed descriptions on this slide.
3.	Review of Data	It was questioned why there was a N/A factor for the age of search data – NC stated that it is not a legal requirement for a person to disclose their age during a S&S. The panel raised the question on if the demographic data of the community resolutions could be disclosed or for the "substance seized, person not arrested" outcome. NC stated that this is not



		applicable for a S&S panel, but more for the Criminal Justice Board. Panel spotted that there is no slide which highlights what grounds 10-17 year olds were being searched for.  NC mentioned that there will be a S&S commission in April, people attending will gain a greater insight into S&S data.  Panel Spotted that there has been an increase in disproportionality for black 10-17 year olds (3.5 times vs 2.8 times for adults) – a cause for concern.  It was stated that black males are 5.8 times more likely to be searched nationally, so Wolverhampton is significantly lower (2.8 times).
4.	Stop and Search Body Worn Video review – randomly selected by Chair PH	S&S 1 <sup>st</sup> Video – panel suggested that the recording was stopped too early as we did not see the outcome of the search (search receipt being passed across. Overall, appropriate actions.  S&S 2 <sup>nd</sup> Video – Reasonable grounds to search, appropriate actions.
5.	Use of Force Body Worn Video review – randomly selected by Chair PH	UoF 1 <sup>st</sup> Video (compliant handcuffing) – appropriate actions. UoF 2 <sup>nd</sup> Video (physical restraining) – appropriate actions following on from a DV report.
6.	AOB	CM mentioned that there may need be another Vice Chair appointed.
