Car parking changes in Birmingham City Centre: Weaman Street and Steelhouse Lane

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Birmingham City Council is proposing to improve traffic management, in Birmingham City Centre, through the implementation of the Snow Hill Phase 3a – Newhall Street Traffic Management scheme.

The traffic management scheme will impact, current, parking arrangements for operational vehicles within Birmingham City Centre on Steelhouse Lane, and Weaman Street.

The Snow Hill Phase 3a – Newhall Street Traffic Management scheme will consist of traffic management improvements and the introduction of new pay and display in the wider Snow Hill Area.

West Midlands Police will retain two car parking spaces at Steelhouse Lane and obtain eight newly created Police bays on Weaman Street.

DECISION

I approve the proposed changes to car parking spaces, proposed by Birmingham City Council under the Snow Hill Phase 3a – Newhall Street Traffic Management scheme. This will result in eight new Police parking bays on Weaman Street, and a further two bays to be retained at Steelhouse Lane.
